

How to get to KMUTNB from the Suvarnabhumi Airport

(Distance 40 km. / Google map: <https://goo.gl/maps/96LfF>)

Option 1. Direct taxi from/to the airport

The fare ranges around 300 - 400 THB depending on the traffic condition (excluded Taxi airport area fee charge 50 Thai Baht and toll way around 75 THB must be paid by passenger) . Taxis are everywhere in Bangkok so only use taxis that use their meters. Print out the taxi card below and show it to the taxi driver.

To KMUTNB

Option 2. Airport Link

The airport link is the direct sky train line that runs from the airport to the city. For those coming from abroad and wishing to visit KMUTNB, the airport link Station is situated at the ground floor of the airport.

➤ Airport Link City Line ➤ the fare ranges from 15 to about 45 Thai Baht. The SA City Line makes 6 stops on the way before arriving at its final stopping point at the Pyathai Station. The other midway Stations are, Lad Krabang Station, Thab Chang Station, Hua Mark Station, Ramkhamhaeng Station, Makkasan Station, and the Rajprarop Station .It takes just 40 minutes

Passengers using both links would stop at the Phaya Thai station (City Line) or Makkasan Station (Express Line). To facilitate your trip to KMUTNB it is advisable to get on a taxi which would take you directly to KMUTNB. (King Mongkut’s University of Technology North Bangkok / Technology Pranakorn Nuah). Then, tell the taxi driver to take you to Technology Pranakorn Nuah because most Thais are familiar with that name or use the taxi card above. It’s close to the Rama 7 Bridge. The fare ranges from about 100-150 Thai Baht depending on the traffic condition.

Option 3. Airport Limousine

You can as well book for an airport limousine but this is more expensive but more comfortable. The price ranges from about 750-2,000 Thai Baht depending on the brand of the limousine, if you encounter any problems on your way to KMUTNB. You shouldn’t hesitate to contact us by phone.

KMUTNB Dormitory Regulations:

1. Gate is closed at 11 P.M. /opened at 5 A.M., In case of coming back late because of activities at the University, students have to show official letter as a proof.
2. Visitors from outside are allowed in the lobby area 1st floor only.
3. Pets are not allowed.
4. Cooking in the dormitory is not allowed.
5. Students have to dress up polite at the dormitory public area.
6. The room should be kept clean at all times. Do not leave your belongings in front of the room.
7. Stealing public stuff is prohibited.
8. Any kinds of weapons are prohibited.
9. Any drugs, alcohol and smoking cigarettes are prohibited.
10. Making noise or fighting is forbidden.
11. Do not enter to the separated for opposite sex dormitory (males may not enter female living accommodations and females may not enter male living accommodations)
12. Do not give keycard to any outsiders for entering in the room and guesthouse area.
13. Do not change room decoration and move any appliance. Nailing/drilling in the wall is forbidden (500 baht fine for each hole).
14. Do not throw objects out the window or balcony.
15. Do not use electric appliances with old or custom plugs.
16. Do not hang clothes out to dry on the terrace railings.

2.Off-campus

For those planning to stay for a longer period or would like to enjoy the extra independence of student life should rent the room off-campus. There are a variety of privately accommodations surrounding the campus with reasonably price. Prices range for air-condition room 5,000 – 7,000 THB per month and fan room 3,500 – 5,000 THB, excluded electricity and water. Two or three months' rental deposit is required.
